ACTS 27–28

Paul was a prisoner because he taught about Jesus. A soldier named Julius took Paul onto a ship to travel to Rome. The wind made it difficult to sail.

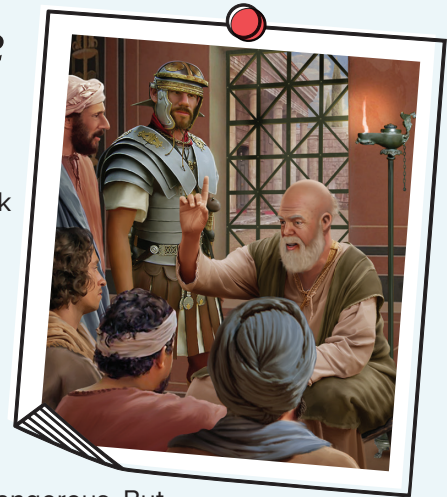
Paul told the captain and Julius, “The trip ahead is dangerous.” The captain wanted to find a safer place for his ship. The ship sailed into a large storm that lasted several days.

Paul said, “I knew this trip would be dangerous. But do not be afraid. An angel told me everyone on the ship would live.” Paul knew God would take care of them.

The next morning, the ship hit land and was wrecked. All the men jumped off the ship and floated or swam for the shore. They were on the island of Malta.

Paul healed sick people in Malta and told people about Jesus. After three months, Paul sailed to Rome. Paul and the soldier guarding Paul stayed in a house. Paul spoke to the Jews in Rome. People came to his house to talk to him about God and Jesus. Paul continued to tell about Jesus anytime he could.
