Kid's MidWeek Bible Verses

$K-2^{nd}$ Grade (8 Verses)

- Genesis 1:31 God saw all that he had made, and it was very good indeed. Evening came and then morning: the sixth day.
- 1 John 4:21 And we have this command from him: The one who loves God must also love his brother and sister.
- Joshua 24:24 So the people said to Joshua, "We will worship the Lord our God and obey Him."
- Psalm 56:3 When I am afraid, I will trust you.
- Psalm 119:11 I have treasured your word in my heart so that I may not sin against you.
- James 1:22 But be doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.
- **Romans 10:9** If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 Give thanks in everything; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

3rd -5th Grade (All of the K-2nd Verses plus additional 8, 16 total verses)

- 1 Chronicles 16:9 Sing to him; sing praise to him; tell about all of his wondrous works!
- Isaiah 45:5 Lam the Lord, and there is no other; there is no God but me. I will strengthen you, though you do not know me.
- Matthew 28:19-20 Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.
- Luke 19:10 For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save the lost.
- John 13:35 By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.
- Acts 4:12 There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to people by which we must be saved.
- Ephesians 2:8 For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God's gift.
- **1 Timothy 4:12** Don't let anyone despise your youth, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity.

Bonus Verses

- **Deuteronomy 16:17** Everyone must appear with a gift suited to his means, according to the blessing the Lord your God has given you.
- Proverbs 22:1 A good name is to be chosen over great wealth; favor is better than silver and gold.
- Isaiah 6:8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord asking: Who should I send? Who will go for us? I said: Here I am. Send me.
- Malachi 3:10 "Bring the full tenth into the storehouse so that there may be food in my house. Test me in this way," says the Lord of Armies. "See if I will not open the floodgates of heaven and pour out a blessing for you without measure."
- Luke 2:52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and with people.
- **John 4:24** God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in Spirit and in truth.
- 1 Corinthians 3:16 Don't you yourselves know that you are God's temple and that the Spirit of God lives in you?
- **2 Timothy 2:15** Be diligent to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who doesn't need to be ashamed, correctly teaching the word of truth.
- **1 Peter 4:9** Be hospitable to one another without complaining.
